Tiatr "Khot" staged by Sao Bartolemeu Sports & Cultural Association, Chora and Tiatr "Kanni Odruxttachi" staged by Ashwamedh Media Production have won second and third Prizes respectively. The Consolation prize was awarded to Tiatr "Oh Mojea Rajea" staged by Kala Manch Sports & Cultural Club, Chinchinim.

The first prize for best acting in male category was bagged by Shri. Benzer Fernandes for the role of Rocky in the Tiatr "I Love You" whereas the second prize was awarded to Shri.
