



Classical Dance Festival organized by Kala Academy Goa and the West Zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur was initiated in the year 1994 – 95. West zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur under its scheme "Nupur" implemented the scheme of classical dance festivals in its component states including Goa, Gujarat, Rajasthan, etc.

The first such festival organised by Kala Academy Goa in association with West Zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur was organized in march 1995 in the precincts of Shree Mahalasa Saunsthan, Mardol as the festival was basically a temple based Classical Dance Festival. Shree Devi Mahalasa is believed to be Mohini incarnation of Lord Vishnu during Samudra Manthana (ocean Churning) which enticed the Daitya's and Asura's (Demons) with the divine dance performance.

Ever since its inception, Kala Academy with the support of West Zone Cultural Centre, Udaipur and venue courtesy of Shree Mahalsa Saunsthan, Mardol, has successfully organized this festival for last 25 years with the participation of national and international level performers in various classical dance styles such as Bharatnatyam, Kathak, Odissi, Kuchipudi, Mohiniattam, Kathakali, and Manipuri. This festival is considered amongst the top ten classical dance festivals of India. The galaxy of eminent performers in the past festival supports the credentials and status of this festival. It has also enabled to espouse keen interest amongst Goan youngsters to learn the classical dance forms of India. Kala Academy has also faculty of Indian music & Dance which imparts training in Bharatanatyam and Kathak which has helped numerous young Goan students to learn these Classical Dance Forms. This year the festival will witness the performances of Ayswaria Waria (Mohiniattam)-Vadodara, Bhavana Reddy (Kuchipudi)-New Delhi, Priyadarsini Govind (Bharatanatyam) - Chennai, Malti Shyam & Group (Kathak Group Choreography)-New Delhi, Purva Dhanashree (Vilasini Natyam)-Hyderabad, Madhulita Mohapatra and artists of Nrityantar-Bengaluru, (Odissi Group Choreography), besides Goa's Dance institutions Nruthyalaya School of Dance & Music, Margao under guidance of Guru Durgalakshmi Rajan (Bharatanatyam Group Choreography) & Pranam foundation Academy of Dance and Music, Ponda's Rekha Madkaikar & her students (Kathak Group Choreography).

She is the recipient of the coveted Central Government Award Sangeet Natak Akademi's Bismillah Khan Yuva Puraskar and has received Lifetime Award for Contribution to Kuchipudi Dance by Telugu Cultural Association, Houston Texas, FICCI Young Women Achievers Award, Femina North Powerlist Award. In her career spanning over two decades, Bhavana has toured multiple times USA, Canada, Europe, South East Asia and United Arab Emirates. Priyadarsini Govind is one of the foremost Bharatanatyam dancers among the current generation. Trained by two stalwarts, Kalaimamani S.K. Rajarathnam Pillai and Padma Bhushan Smt. Kalanidhi Naryanan, Priyadarsini has imbibed this art form from the best. With her natural aptitude for abhinaya coupled with her passion and dedication to her art, Priyadarsini has become a flag bearer for Smt. Kalanidhi's padam repertoire. Priyadarsini's nritta or pure dance is intense and vigorous. A dancer known for her adherence to tradition, Priyadarsini manages to seamlessly blend new choreography with the traditional, thereby gently redefining the boundaries of Bharatanatyam repertoire.

Priyadarsini has been performing in prestigious venues all over India and the globe, taking Bharatanatyam to many major International and national Festivals as a soloist. She is actively engaged in performing, creating new repertoires for dance and teaching. Among her recent works are a unique set of instructional DVDs for Baratanatyam conceptualized and created for Kalakriya covering the entire Bharatanatyam margam as well as focusing on capturing the documenting Kalanidhi Nayarayan's teaching and practice of abhinaya. Priyadarsini Govind has been honoured with many awards for her excellence and service in the field



of arts which include the Nritya Kalanidhi by the Madras Music Academy (2019), Sangeet Natak Akademi Award (2012), Yuva Kala Bharathi, Kalaimamani, Nrityachoodamani to name a few. She has served as the Director of the Kalakshetra Foundation between August 5th, 2013 and June 19th, 2017. She is also the founder and director of Nava Darshana-an initiative that teaches dancers to view dance, holistically.

Born & brought up in New Delhi, her mastering of technique & depth of 'Abhinaya' have earned her the privilege of performing on the inaugural day of the December Festival 2000 at the Music Academy, Chennai. She was judged the best dancer at the Spirit of Youth concerts

1999 and was conferred the prestigious Dr. MGR Award. Since then, she has performed in several prestigious festivals in India and abroad which include Khajuraho Dance Festival (2008), Nrityotsava, Sangeet Natak Akademi, Raipur (2016), Natya Kala Conference, Chennai (2018), Vilasni'06, Festival of Vilasini Natyam, Delhi (2006) etc.


