ONE ACT PLAY COMPETITION AT HIGH SCHOOL AND HIGHER SECONDARY/COLLEGE LEVEL

The Kala Academy Goa annually organizes One Act Play Competition in Konkani, Marathi and English at High School and Higher Secondary/College Level at Kala Academy Complex or at any suitable venue. The educational institutions from the state of Goa desirous of participating in the competition should submit their applications in the prescribed format within the stipulated last date for receipt of entries. However, the following rules and regulations shall be applicable for the competitions:

1. The competition shall be limited for One act plays in Konkani, Marathi and English languages. The competition shall not be held unless 5 schools, 5 HSS/Colleges participate in the competition in each language.
2. Any Govt. Recognized High School and Higher Secondary School/College from Goa shall be eligible to participate in the competition. Only the bonafide students belonging to the respective schools, Higher Secondary and Colleges shall be allowed to enact the plays.
3. Each High School and Higher Secondary School/College is entitled to present maximum 3 one act plays (one in each language).
4. The High School and Higher Secondary School/College shall have to bear the responsibility of getting the printed and hand written plays approved by Govt., if necessary.
5. The entry responsibility of paying remuneration and seeking permission of the writer for staging the concerned one act play shall have to be borne by the respective institutions. Kala Academy Goa shall not be responsible for any such lapses on the part of participating institution on this count.
6. **Full and correct names of the artists enacting the play with their respective roles, name of the director, all the technicians including set designer, background music, light designer, costume, makeup etc. should be clearly mentioned in the prescribed format given by the Kala Academy and 4 copies of it to be submitted on the day of performance i.e well in advance atleast 1 hr. prior to the performance (Format is enclosed). No changes will be entertained once the list of Artists/technicians is furnished to Kala Academy. If it is found such changes are made later, the concerned artists/technicians will not be considered for the individual prizes.**
7. The script copy of One Act Play/plays is to be presented to Kala Academy on the day of performance. This copy/copies shall not be returned.

8. The High School and Higher Secondary School/College is required to furnish the detailed list of the artists along with the full name and the role in the play. No fake/nick name will be accepted in the list of the artists. The Kala Academy reserves the right to verify the identity of the participants on the information provided by the participating institutions. On violation of the above rule, the concerned School, Higher Secondary/College will be debarred from the competition for the next two years and their prizes and certificates for the year of default will be withheld.
9. Male roles by female artists and vice-versa will not be allowed in the competition (Subject to requirement of the script).
10. The duration of the One Act Play shall not be less than Thirty minutes and more than one hour. If the selected play exceeds the time limit, it should be curtailed so as to fulfill the condition. **In case the time limit is exceeded the concerned performance (one act play) will not be considered for the prize by the judges panel.**
11. **Each one act play will be allowed maximum 30 minutes for their stage setup and maximum 10 minutes time slot for clearing the set and the stage immediately after the one act play is over. Any violation of the same shall be viewed seriously to the extent of considering the said institution ineligible for the performance prize.**
12. **Every High School and Higher Secondary School/College desirous for participating in the competition shall have to pay Rs.100/- per one act play as entry fee.** The amount shall not be refunded even if the application is rejected.
13. No individual artist shall participate in more than one play including artists, directors and technicians etc.
14. The High School and Higher Secondary School/College shall have to stage its play as per the programme schedule finalized by the Kala Academy. No request to change the programme schedule will be entertained.
15. If any play entered in the entry form for presentation is withdrawn without seeking permission of the Kala Academy, the respective institution shall be debarred from the competition for next three years.
16. The participating institution shall be allowed to seek guidance or direction from any theatre personality.
17. Only ten persons besides the artists enacting the play will be allowed on stage as helpers.
18. The Kala Academy shall provide the facility of light, sound system, stage with front and back drop and other material free of charge on par with other Drama Competitions subject to availability. In case the competition is held at any other venue, the available infrastructure facility of the concerned auditorium will be at the disposal.

19. The right of accepting or rejecting the entries is reserved by the Kala Academy.
- 20. Once the entry is submitted the name of the One Act Play shall be allowed to be changed within 2 days from the last date for receipt of entries. If the 2 day limit falls on holidays, the working days shall be counted. The programme thereafter will be finalized by Kala Academy Goa and will be intimated to all participating institutions. The One Act Play will not be allowed to be changed thereafter. If any institution violates the above rule, their performance will not be considered for group performance prizes.**
21. The Kala Academy shall appoint the panel of judges and their decision will be final and binding to all concerned. No protests shall be entertained on the results given by the panel of judges appointed by Kala Academy Goa.
22. If any student or group of students from any High School, Higher Secondary School and College is found purposely creating obstacle for any show of One Act Play in the competition, the respective High School, Higher Secondary School and College will be debarred from the participation in the competition for the next two years in succession.
23. The prize for the best playwright shall be given if the same is recommended by the panel of judges in the competition, if the One Act Play is specially written for the competition. However, the playwright should be presently residing in Goa or should be the native of Goa.
24. The participating institutions will be paid the rental charges of one vehicle at the rate per km. fixed as per Kala Academy rule. The High School, Higher Secondary School and College shall not be entitled for any other payment, except prizes.
25. Incomplete and late entries shall not be entertained.
26. The Kala Academy reserves the right to make any changes in rules and regulations at any point of time or stage of the competition and such changes shall be binding on all concerned.
27. In case of any doubts regarding the rules and regulations, the decision of the Chairman of Kala Academy shall be final and binding.
28. Prizes shall not be split.
29. The prizes in this competition for each language and each category i.e. High School and Hr. Sec. School/College level are as below:

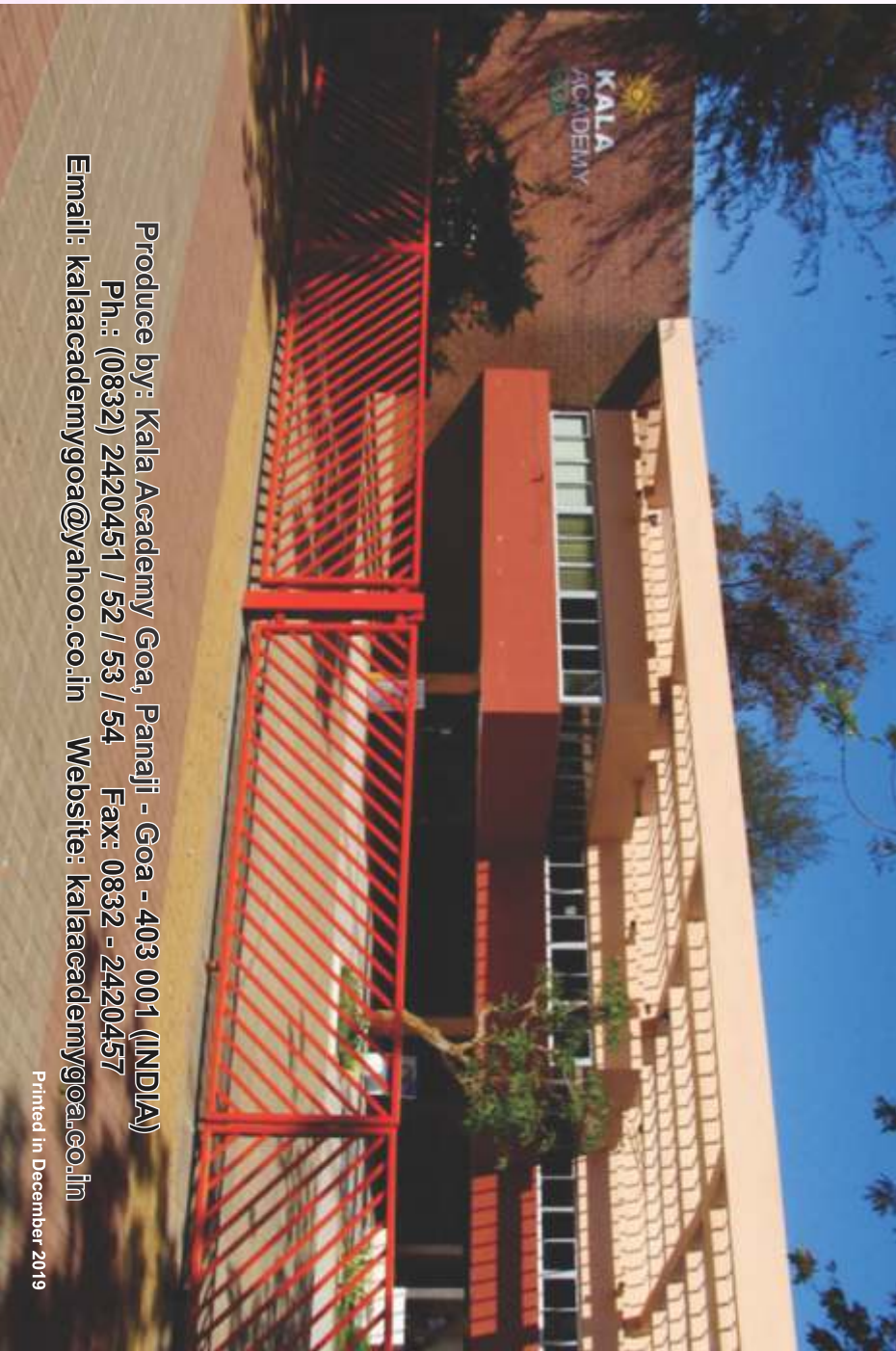
