

COMPETITION OF CHILDREN DRAWING - PAINTING 2019-20

INTRODUCTION:

With a view to encourage children in the field of Visual Art and to widen the scope to develop healthy competitive spirit at a tender age, Kala Academy Goa shall organise a Drawing - Painting Competition, every year at appropriate venues decided by Kala Academy Goa.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1. The Competition shall be organized on 26th November 2019 at 3.30p.m. sharp and will conclude latest by 5.00p.m.
- 2. This Competition shall be organised in the following four categories:
 - (a) 'A' Category Primary Level (1st to 4th Std.)
 - (b) 'B' Category Middle School Level (5th to 7th Std.)
 - (c) 'C' Category High School Level (8th to 10th Std.)
 - (d) 'D' Category Higher Secondary Level (11th to 12th Std.)
- 3. The Competition will be held on 26th November 2019, Taluka wise at the following centres/venues:

4. The theme for the Competition will be as follows:-

Primary Level

Any topic of choice.

Middle School Level

(a) Our Goa (b) Nature (c) Circus (d) Kites (e) Wonderland

(f) Fish Market (g) My Favourite Sports / Game

High School Level

(a) Sea & Ships (b) Wildlife (c) Country side (d) Fort (e) Space Station

(f) Aquarium (g) Spice farm or Ecofarm

Higher Secondary School Level

(a) Independence Day (15th August) Celebration (b) International Film Festival of India (IFFI)

(c) My Vision of Goa (d) Water Sports (e) Life of Fishermen (f) Filmcity / Film Studio

(g) Cultural Event / Cultural Festival

- 5. Entry forms/rules and regulations are available at the respective centres/venues and Kala Academy Goa, Campal, Panaji, during office hours on working days.
- 6. The Kala Academy shall only provide simple cartridge paper A4 off white to all the participants in the competition. Rest of the painting material is to be arranged by the participants, as per their choice.
- 7. For the 'D' category (Higher Secondary level), water colours will be the medium and for the other categories, mixed media ie. wax crayons, pencil colours, water colours etc. would be acceptable. No sketch pens are allowed in this competition.
- 8. The participants will be allowed to participate at the taluka level where his/her school is situated and not in the taluka where he/she resides.
- 9. The duration of the competition shall be one hour thirty minutes. No extra time shall be given on any grounds.
- 10. Parents shall not be allowed inside the venue of the Competition when the Competition is in progress.
- 11. The participants will carry their own water bottle, drawing and painting material and rough white cloth for cleaning, etc.
- 12. Colour should not be thrown on the floor or side wall while executing the work or after the competition is over.
- 13. The entry should be submitted within the due date after declaration of the competition. The last date to accept the forms at the respective centres or at Kala Academy is 20th November 2019. Incomplete and late entries will not be accepted. As such, no spot entries at the venues/s of the competition will be entertained.
- 14. No travelling expenses shall be given by the Kala Academy except light refreshments to all the participants after the competition.
- 15. The prizes in each category will be as under:

- 16. Prize winner paintings from each taluka will be qualified for the State Level Competition.
- 17 The Exhibition of selected work shall be arranged by the Kala Academy Goa at its Art Gallery or at any other Art Gallery as per availability and suitability for an appropriate period.
- A panel of judges shall be appointed to select the work for display in the exhibition and also to award the prizes. The decision of the judges shall be final and binding to all concerned. No correspondence shall be entertained in respect of results declared by the Kala Academy Goa.
- 19. In case there is insufficient participation in any category at Taluka level, all the works received shall be treated as for State level competition and the prizes shall be awarded accordingly.
- 20. The Kala Academy reserves the right to make any changes in the rules. Decision of Kala Academy Goa shall be final and binding to all.
